


Mr. Yoham's Music Program is a curriculum designed by composer Yoham Ortiz to introduce young children to

creative thinking through music.

The program is structured around the 3 basic steps that lead to creativity:


INSPIRATION→THOUGHT→COMMUNICATION™





In class, children are encouraged to recognize when they are inspired. We discuss how inspiration is the beginning of every thought, and find creative ways to communicate those thoughts.

Music becomes the agent through which thoughts are communicated.





Mr. Yoham's music program encourages the idea that musical instruments are tools with which to express the music that comes from within you.

In other words: you are the instrument.

Students are encouraged to choose a tool to communicate their thoughts and inspiration: voice, hands, or other parts of their bodies.

Students learn basic concepts of conducting and being conducted.
This activity is a favorite for the children, as they each get a chance to conduct their classmates!

We learn about musical instruments from all over the world:

African kora
piano
percussion
Chinese erhu

violin, brass, and clarinet families and many others




We cover many topics:

Many children step out of their comfort zone of shyness and sing (solo) to the class.



Children quickly grasp the idea of communicating a thought through music notation. In the final class, each child and teacher composes a short piece on music paper, then Mr. Yoham plays everyone's music notation aloud for the class on guitar. Every composition is received with great applause!
